

## From the Desk of Todd Rockoff, President and CEO

To Our Valued Members,

Today we were informed that a Taglit Day Program participant has tested positive for pneumonia. Although their COVID-19 test came back negative, we know that many people in our Taglit program are at higher risk for coronavirus and therefore, out of caution and concern (and in consultation with our medical advisory committee), we are closing the effected room for two weeks.

The impacted group will not return to Taglit until Tuesday, August 4. Additionally, all participants and staff in this group must be symptom-free (without the aid of medication) for at least 72 hours before returning to Taglit.

Please note that Taglit is being temporarily housed off-site at Congregation Or Chadash and therefore this cautionary decision does not impact our day-to-day operations at the J. Early Childhood Education, Camp J, the pool, the Sarver tennis courts, and the outdoor pickleball courts will remain open.

We continue to closely follow the protocol created by our medical advisory committee (in addition to upholding guidelines from the CDC, the State of Arizona, and Pima County) and to put your health and the health of our team first in all of our decision-making.

As a reminder, this protocol includes:

- Limited group sizes to ensure groups are self-contained and prohibiting mixing of children from different classrooms
- A strict no-visitor policy in Early Childhood, Camp, and Taglit
- Taking the temperature of everyone who has entered the facility, and of all drivers/guardians who are present at ECE, Camp, and Taglit drop-off
- Reducing our capacity in the Sports and Wellness wing of the building by requiring advanced booking in the pool and tennis courts
- Requiring staff to wear masks at all times
- Sanitizing high-touch areas and all equipment throughout the day
- Deep-cleaning and disinfecting the full facility each evening
- Creating one-way “clean” traffic throughout the building
- Training our staff on hygiene practices and complied fully with CDC and State of Arizona guidelines
